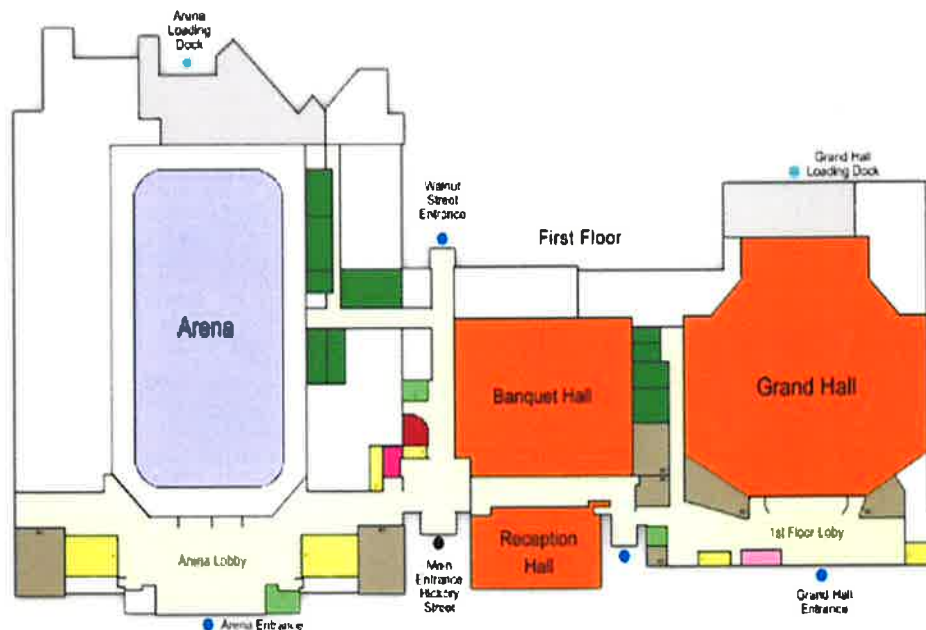

We are currently requiring clients to stay at least 6 feet apart while at the CCC. We are NOT requiring masks while inside the CCC. We do however ask that you wear your mask in the van during outings due to the enclosed area. We also ask for frequent handwashing, and a general awareness for keeping things clean and sanitized while at the CCC. We have to remember that the regulations can change quickly depending on the status of the disease in the county.
